

United Way of Salt Lake Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Community Support Grant Availability

Overview: United Way of Salt Lake's (UWSL) Community Support Grants (formerly Basic Needs) provide support to organizations that meet the basic needs of individuals and families in **Salt Lake, Davis, Summit and Tooele Counties**. United Way of Salt Lake is accepting applications for *Community Infrastructure Grants* and *Program Support Grants*. Community Support grants are distinct from Collective Impact Grants and are not limited to specific geographies or partnerships. UWSL supports basic needs programming in both Collective Impact partnerships and through broader Community Support grants.

Purpose: Community Support Grants (both Community Infrastructure and Program Support) are intended to support programs in the following areas:

- Food/General Financial Support
- Mental/Behavioral Health
- Medical/Dental, and
- Shelter/Safety

Program Support Grants provide up to \$25,000 with a one year funding commitment for program services in the areas described above.

Community Infrastructure Grants provide up to \$100,000 with a one year funding commitment for organizations whose programs/services:

- Are broad in scope (across multiple needs)
- Are large in scale or number of people served
- Play a unique role in terms of overall safety net system infrastructure

Grant Period:

- July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020

Eligibility: Applicant organizations must meet UWSL Grant Eligibility Requirements found at www.uw.org/for-partners. Current Collective Impact grantees may not apply for Community Support grants for programs or services that are funded as part of a Promise Partnership. Organizations may only submit one application per grant type (i.e. infrastructure or program support).

Application Process: An online application will be available at www.uw.org/for-partners beginning on Friday, February 15, 2019. Applications must be completed by Friday, March 15, 2019 at 5:00pm. Applications are approved by UWSL's Board of Directors in May and notice of awards will be provided in June 2019.
