



Conflict of Interest Policy

Statement

No Board member, team member, or board-level committee member (hereafter referred to as committee member) of Utah's Promise / United Way of Salt Lake (UP / UWSL) shall use their position, or the knowledge gained therefrom, in such a manner that a conflict between the interest of the organization and their personal interests arise. The conduct of any business between any Board member, team member, or committee member and UP / UWSL must be fully disclosed and approved by the Board of Directors (hereafter referred to as the Board).

If a Board member, team member, or committee member has an interest in a proposed business transaction with UP / UWSL in the form of any personal or business-related financial interest in the transaction, or in any organizations involved in the transaction, or holds a position as trustee, director, or officer in any such organization, they must make full disclosure of such interest in a timely manner.

Any Board member, team member, or committee member who is aware of a potential conflict of interest with respect to any matter coming before the Board or any committee is obligated to make a timely discloser of such a conflict of interest to the entire Board.

Definitions

A conflict of interest may arise in a situation where committee member relationships, financial interests, or other personal/professional considerations compromise the objectivity, judgment, and integrity and/or ability to perform board member commitments. A perceived conflict of interest may arise in situations where committee members have financial interests or associations with organizations of which the activities or engagement could appear to be biased or influenced by the relationship with UP / UWSL.

Disclosure

To implement this policy, Board members, team members, and committee members of UP / UWSL must submit annual disclosures on a form approved by the Board and will disclose any conflict or potential conflict.

These annual disclosures will be reviewed by the Governance and Ethics Committee for any actual or potential conflict(s). These conflicts will be reviewed and resolved by a vote of the Board of Directors.

Addressing Conflicts

If, after a thorough review, it is determined that the business transaction is the most advantageous transaction or arrangement for UP / UWSL, the Board shall determine by a majority vote if the transaction or arrangement is in UP / UWSL's best interest, for its own benefit, and whether it is fair and reasonable. The person(s) with the actual or potential conflicts will be excused from the meeting during the vote.

Records of Proceedings

The minutes of the Board of Directors, and Governance and Ethics Committee shall contain the names of the persons who disclosed or otherwise were found to have a financial interest in connection with an actual or possible conflict of interest, the nature of the financial interest, any action taken to determine whether a conflict of interest was present, and the Board's decision as to whether a conflict of interest in fact existed.

The minutes shall also contain the names of the persons who were present for discussions relating to the transaction or arrangement, the content of the discussion, including any alternatives to the proposed transaction or arrangement, and a record of the vote taken in connection with the proceedings.
