ABUSE/ NEGLECT

Adult Protective Services investigates reports of any form of abuse, neglect and exploitation of vulnerable adults; 801-538-3567, or 800-371-7897.

ADVOCACY/ COMMUNITY SUPPORT

Crisis Line of Utah County is a 24-hour hotline that helps callers in crisis and gives emergency referrals; 801-691-5433.

Grandfamilies of Utah County provides support, assistance, services and programs to grandparents who are raising children; 801-373-4765.

Long-Term Care Ombudsman Programs serve to investigate and advocate for the rights of residents of long term care facilities to ensure and enhance the quality of life and care of residents; 801-229-3809.
