Cottonwood High School: 5715 S 1300 E, Murray, UT 84121	Math tutoring with high school students	Monday - Friday, between 2:45 - 3:45 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 1 day a week for semester.	Cottonwood serves 1,700 students, 1/3 of whom live within the City of South Salt Lake. The student body includes speakers of over 40 languages. 12% are refugees, and 18% are English Language Learners. 50% qualify for free/reduced lunch. Volunteers with strong math backgrounds provide 1-on-1 or small group support to students who are either credit deficient and working on packets, or could use extra support in an afterschool or classroom setting.
South Salt Lake Math Tutoring	Math tutoring with elementary school students	any day Mon - Thurs; 4:00 - 5:00 p.m.	Tutor elementary school students at Woodrow Wilson Elementary and Roosevelt Elementary in math during their afterschool programs. Volunteers are required to attend a volunteer orientation on Fridays at 3:00 p.m. at the City of South Salt Lake.
Sandy Elementary: 8725 S 280 E, Sandy, UT 84070	Math tutoring with elementary school students	any day Mon - Thurs; 3:30 - 5:00 p.m.	Tutor elementary school students in math during their afterschool program. Volunteers are required to pass a background check prior to volunteering.
Mill Creek Elementary, 3761 1100 E, Salt Lake City, UT 84106	Math tutoring with elementary school students	any day Mon - Fri; 8:40 a.m. - 3:20 p.m. Volunteer should commit to one hour a week.	Tutor elementary school students in math and STEM subjects during school. Volunteers will work one-on-one or in small groups with students.
Granite Park Junior High School: 3031 S 200 E, Salt Lake City, UT 84115 (South Salt Lake)	Math tutoring with junior high students	Any day Mon - Thurs, shifts between 8:20 a.m. - 2:50 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 1-2 days a week for semester.	Granite Park is rich in diversity with speakers of 44 languages representing 60 countries. About 90% of students are eligible for free/reduced lunch. Volunteers go into classrooms to learn a lesson with students and then go around working with students as they practice what they have just learned.

Volunteers will mentor and tutor identified students with math and/or reading. A positive and consistent mentor can make all the difference in a child's school experience.
Granite Park Junior High School: 3031 S 200 E, Salt Lake City, UT 84115 (South Salt Lake)	Reading tutoring with junior high students	Mon-Thurs, 10:55-11:55 a.m.; alternating days, 8:20-9:35 a.m. & 1:30-2:45 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 2 days a week for semester.	Granite Park is rich in diversity with speakers of 44 languages representing 60 countries. About 90% of students are eligible for free/reduced lunch. Volunteers work 1-on-1 with students and supervised by a trained reading tutor. Volunteers read texts with the student and help with word composition.
James E. Moss Elementary School: 4399 S 500 E, Salt Lake City, UT 84107 (Millcreek)	Reading tutoring with elementary students	any day Mon - Thurs between 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 1-2 days a week for the semester, preferable the full school year.	Moss Elementary serves 600 students, and 94% qualify for free/reduced lunch. Over 35 languages and 51 countries are represented in the school. Volunteers work 1-on-1 with students doing simple reading exercises.
Woodrow Wilson Elementary School: 2567 Main St, Salt Lake City, UT 84115	Reading tutoring with elementary students	Monday-Thurs day, varying shifts from 9:20 a.m. - 2:40 p.m. Volunteers school commit to 30 minutes to 1 hour each week.	Read with students who are English Language Learners to practice reading fluency, sight words, letter recognition, and reading comprehension skills.
West Kearns Elementary School: 4900 S 4620 W, Kearns, UT 84118	Reading tutoring with elementary students	any day Mon - Thurs; 9:00-11:30 a.m. for Pre-K-2nd grade and 12:45-3:45 p.m. for 3rd-6th grade	Volunteers will work with our AmeriCorps Read, Graduate, Succeed mentor to be paired with struggling readers to help students improve their literacy proficiency through dyad and small group reading strategies .

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Mill Creek Elementary , 3761 1100 E, Salt Lake City, UT 84106	Reading tutoring with elementary students	any day Mon - Friday between 8: 40 a.m. - 3 p.m. Volunteers should commit to one hour each week.	Mill Creek Elementary serves 437 students, almost 70% of whom qualify for free/reduced lunch. Volunteer will tutor students in reading through a structured program that focuses on 1-on-1 reading and peer group reading for students who need a little bit of extra support.
Sandy Elementary: 8725 S 280 E, Sandy, UT 84070	Reading tutoring with elementary students	Mondays & Wednesdays or Tuesdays & Thursdays from 11:00 a.m.- 11:30 a.m. Volunteers should commit to two days a week.	Ms. Nelson's 4th grade class is excited to learn and has lots of books to read! They just need you, a helpful volunteer to lead small group reading circles. Reading in small groups can help students get the attention they need to move up to the next level. No experience necessary, just a love for children and learning. All volunteer are required to complete Canyon School District's background check.
Copperview Elementary School: 8449 S Monroe St, Midvale, UT 84047	Afterschool Volunteers	any day Mon-Thurs, 3:20-6:00 p.m.; Fri, 1:40-6:00 p.m.	Copperview's afterschool program focuses on supporting what students are learning in the classroom. They are looking for volunteers to work one-on-one and in small groups with students to help with homework and other planned enrichment activities. All volunteers are required to complete the Canyon School District background check.
Lincoln Elementary School: 450 E 3700 S, South Salt Lake, UT 84115	Afterschool reading tutoring and homework help with elementary students	any day Mon - Thurs, 3:30-4:30 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 1 hour per week for the semester.	Lincoln serves 650 students, and is a Title I school with 95% of students qualifying for free/reduced lunch. The school has a diverse population comprised of many immigrant and refugee families. 25 languages are spoken at the school, and a majority of students are English Language Learners. Volunteers work in the afterschool program helping students with reading and homework.
South Kearns Elementary School: 5241 S 4280 W, Kearns, UT 84118	1st Grade Friday Helper	Friday morning for an hour. Volunteers should commit to a weekly or bi-weekly basis.	Volunteer to prep the first grader's weekly packets. Usually a task done by the teachers, volunteers can open up this time for the teacher to focus on planning for the week ahead.
South Salt Lake community centers (various throughout South Salt Lake City)	Afterschool mentoring, tutoring, and recreational activities with all ages	any day Mon - Fri various after school times including after 5:00 p.m. Commitment is flexible	South Salt Lake offers afterschool programs at centers throughout the city. Volunteers help students with homework and then with fun activities. Attend a 1-hour orientation on the 1st or 3rd Friday of the month at 3:00 p.m. at the Promise South Salt Lake Office (3rd Floor at City Hall: 220 Morris Ave #200, SLC). Adults must pass a background check. Teen volunteers (16-17) must complete a minor consent form.

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South Kearns Elementary School: 5241 S 4280 W, Kearns, UT 84118	Gym Class Helpers	Wednesdays, 1:15 p.m. - 2:05 p.m. Volunteers should commit to one hour a week.	Volunteers to work one-on-one with 1st and 2nd grade special ed students during their PE time. Volunteers will be active and moving with the students!
Sandy Elementary: 8725 S 280 E, Sandy, UT 84070	Afterschool Mentoring Program	M - F, 3:30 - 4:30 p.m. Volunteers should commit to an hour a month.	Volunteers will be paired with a child to meet with at least once a month. Volunteers will get to know their assigned student by providing homework support and playing games together. All materials are provided. Background check required.
Hillcrest High School: 7350 S 900 E, Midvale, UT 84047	English Language Learner Student Support	any day Mon - Fri, shifts between 7:05 a.m. - 2:25 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 1 day a week for 1-2 hours.	Volunteers will support students who are learning English in their U.S. History, Math, Geography, or Language Arts class. Many of these students are refugees who are not only learning a new language, but also how to navigate the U.S. education system. Volunteers can help minimize these barriers, and support students in flourishing in class. Volunteer must complete background check.
Cottonwood High School: 5715 S 1300 E, Murray, UT 84121	Mentor 2.0	Weekly communication plus once a month in-person meeting from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. (dates vary) Volunteers should commit to 3-4 years until mentee graduates.	Cottonwood serves approximately 1,750 students, 450 of whom live within the City of South Salt Lake. The student body includes speakers of over 40 languages. 12% are refugees, and 18% are English Language Learners. 50% qualify for free/reduced lunch. The Mentor 2.0 program focuses on college readiness for high school students, particularly those who will be first-generation college students. Mentors and mentees communicate weekly via email within a protected online platform, discussing important topics such as professionalism, perseverance, and career choices. Mentors and mentees also meet once a month for an activity at the high school. Mentors with college degrees and professional certifications are preferred
West Kearns Elementary School: 4900 S 4620 W, Kearns, UT 84118	Working with preschool students	any day Mon - Thurs between 9-11:30 a.m. and 12:30-3:30 p.m. Volunteers should commit to at least 1 hr per week	West Kearns serves 800 students pre-K-6th, and 83% qualify for free/reduced lunch. West Kearns has a diverse population; 1/3 of students are English-Language Learners. Volunteers help the preschool teacher by doing activities with students.

South Kearns Elementary School: 5241 S 4280 W, Kearns, UT 84118	Working with preschool students	any day Mon - Thurs, 8:15-11:15 a.m. or 12:00-3:00 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 1 hours per week.	South Kearns serves more than 300 students with 80% qualifying for free/reduced lunch. About 58% percent of students are minorities, and 35% are English Language Learners. Volunteers help the preschool teacher by doing activities with students.
Guadalupe School: 1385 N 1200 W, Salt Lake City, UT 84116 (Rose Park)	Adult English tutoring with small groups	Tuesdays & Thursdays, 7:00 - 9:00 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 1 day a week for 2 hours	Volunteer teach English to adult immigrants and refugees at Guadalupe School. Volunteers attend a 1-hour orientation, observe other tutors, and then start tutoring in small groups!
Davis Community Learning Center: 210 E Center St, Clearfield, UT 84015	Adult English tutoring with individuals	any day Mon - Thurs between 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Volunteers should commit to 1 day a week for 1-2 hours.	Volunteers tutor adult English learners 1-on-1 at Davis Community Learning Center. Volunteers fill out an application, receive training and materials, and are matched with a student.
