When you invest in United Way of Salt Lake, you connect children and families with the supports they need to thrive. [Here are some examples of the impact donors make:](#)

\$5 per month (\$60/year) refers families in crisis to services such as rent assistance, substance abuse counseling, or child care resources.

\$10 per month (\$120/year) equips a recently-immigrated adult with English language instruction, citizenship classes, and employability skills.

\$12 per month (\$144/year) provides individualized reading support for one student so they can read with confidence and stay on grade level.

\$25 per month (\$300/year) enables one student to receive the immunizations needed to enter kindergarten healthy and ready to learn.

\$30 per month (\$360/year) brightens a struggling family's future by giving them regular access to professional mental health counseling.

\$35 per month (\$420/year) gives one student access to financial literacy curriculum so they can learn how to become a financially stable adult.

\$50 per month (\$600/year*) increases access to preschool, personalized interventions for at-risk students, and adult education opportunities.

\$65 per month (\$780/year*) moves a high school student closer to graduation by pairing them with a supportive mentor who helps them prepare for college.

\$85 per month (\$1,020/year*) enables 10 students to receive a vision screening, glasses, and regular access to quality health care.

\$100 per month (\$1,200/year*) pairs an elementary and high school student together in a mentoring program, giving both learning and leadership opportunities.

\$125 per month (\$1,500/year*) gives 60 people a reason to smile by providing them with preventative and restorative dental care, helping eliminate pain and future health problems.
