

# Wasatch County Resource Guide

## HEALTH SERVICES

**5 Minute Clinic** provides services to individuals without health insurance. Services include primary care, blood work, x-rays and basic fracture casting and care; 435-654-1377.

**Heber Valley Hospital** provides emergency medical care. Those without insurance may qualify for a sliding scale fee; 435-654- 2500.

## GENERAL DENTISTRY

**Wasatch County Health Department** provides dental services to low-income Wasatch County families. Services include patient exams, x-rays, prophylaxis (cleaning and scaling), fluoride treatment, sealants, simple restoration and extractions; 435-657- 3307.

## RENT/DEPOSIT ASSISTANCE

**Community Action Services and Food Bank** offers rental assistance. Must have an eviction notice in hand. Also offers rental deposit assistance. Households gross income must be less than 200% of the poverty guideline and have at least one legal resident of the US; 435-654-2182.

## **Department of Workforce Services - Eligibility Services**

**Division** offers rental assistance to families that have at least one child under 18 in the household, a formal eviction notice, and the ability to make future housing payments; 866-435-7414 x3.

## UTILITY ASSISTANCE

**Mountainland HEAT Program** is available every year from the first of November through April.

Emergency services are available during other months of the year on a limited basis; 801- 229-3855.

**The Salvation Army** provides assistance with utility bills for those who have at least one of the following: an elderly adult, an individual with a disability, someone experiencing a medical emergency (power only), or a child under 2 lives in the household; 855-969-0526.

**Department of Workforce Services - Eligibility Services Division** provides short-term assistance. Must have a child under 18 in the home; 866-435-7414 x3.

**Mountainland Weatherization Assistance Program** helps low-income individuals and families reduce energy costs and increase comfort and safety in their homes; 801-229-3850.

**People's Health Clinic** provides medical services to uninsured individuals and families in Summit and Wasatch Counties; 435-333-1850.

**Mountainlands Family Health Center** provides primary healthcare services, immunizations, and more. Offers sliding scale fee for those that are uninsured. Also accepts Medicaid and Medicare insurance; 801-429-2000.

### **GENERAL COUNSELING**

**Summit Community Counseling of Heber** serves all ages, offers individual, couples family therapy, as well as psychological testing. Accepts Medicaid; 801-266-2485.

**Wasatch Mental Health - Wasatch County Family Clinic** provides mental health services for adults and children. Accepts Medicaid and offers sliding scale for those without insurance; 435-654- 3003.
